LAJNA REPORT

The Lajna General meeting started with the recitation of the Holy Quran by Khoshnoor Paracha. The translation was read by Sister Rehana Shezad. Next, Hadith #2, *Five Pillars of Islam*, was read from 40 Gems of Beauty by Bariah Ahmad. The translation was read by Sister Arifa Naseeb.

The Tarbiyyat Workshop was led by our Tarbiyyat Secretary, Sister Qudsia Ghayur, who started off with a PowerPoint on "Taqwa – Keeping the Boundaries Established by Allah". In this PowerPoint, different aspects of Purdah were discussed. An issue discussed was how people make excuses to not observe Purdah, and members were also told that if an elder, parents, or spouses tell you not to observe Purdah, you should not listen to them but continue on observing Purdah. Members were also told to remain steadfast and be firm in their faith. They shouldn't lose their faith and just stop observing Purdah over little reasons.

The Taleem Workshop was led by Sister Salamat Majeed whose topic for the workshop was the book of the Promised Messiah (as) called "Kist-e-Nuh". This book was given 3 names by the Promised Messiah, the main one being Kisht-e-Nuh, then Dawa-tul-Eeman, and Taqwi-a-tul Eeman. Muslim sect on our side

When Republican Pete King holds homeland-security hearings on the radicalization of American Muslims, he must invite members of the Ahmadiyya Community. It has launched an ad campaign to encourage Muslims to be loyal to the United

"There are negative forces working to influence Muslim youth living in the West to become terrorists, and, sadly, they are having some success," a spokesman said yesterday. "We will raise awareness that there is a community of Muslims who actively preach - and practice — the universal teaching of Islam that Muslims have a religious duty to be loyal to their country of residence."

Despite having tens of millions of members worldwide, the Ahmadiyya Community is a fairly minor branch of Islam. It has theological differences with the Sunni and Shia sects, believing that the messiah has already come in the form of Mirza Ghulam Ahmad, an Indian who died in 1908. Its members are often targeted for murder.

That persecution makes it leaders perfect witnesses for King's cause. He wants to know why many Islamic organizations in this country do not support law enforcement against terrorists. He could do worse than start with one that does

MONTHLY JAMA'AT MEETING REPORT

On January 2nd, 2011 from 3pm-5pm the New York Jama'at Monthly Meeting was held. The program began with recitation of the Holy Quran by Shoeb Abulkalam and a poem was read in Urdu by Rizwan Ahmad. This was followed by a brief presentation by Muhammad Afzal sahib on the importance of coming to the masjid for congregational prayers and the importance of leading congregational prayers at home when one cannot make it to the Masjid. This has a profound effect on young children and in their developing a closeness to Allah.

Next Karim Sharif Sahib shared a PowerPoint presentation the importance of education. His main theme reminded us all that we should increase in our education and knowledge as much as possible. He related that Huzoor (aba) has put forth a minimum goal of winning the Nobel Prize. He also spoke about a new program where school and college going students will be recognized for their high achievements not only by having their names posted at the Masjid for everyone to see but also their names will be forwarded to the president and Amir sahib.

This was followed by an interactive session led by our General Secretary, Dr. Ahmad Chaudhry on issues our youth are facing in higher education. Students and, just as importantly, parents need to fully understand what are the major requirements for students to be accepted into good colleges and good programs. It all starts with not only getting good grades but also being prepared for the PSAT's and the SAT's and focusing on extracurricular activities such as volunteering and being members of sports and athletic teams. All of these things combined build a good candidate for college admission. It was also emphasized that the Jama'at has lots of valuable resources through Taleem and Sanat o Tajarat departments where students can join a mentoring program enabling them to interact with others who have excelled in a field of their interest.

Naib Amir Daud Haneef sahib closed the program by talking about how does one deal with despair or desperation. He made two important references. In times of despair and desperation what happens, he asked the gatherers? The answer, a prophet comes to the world. He also pointed out that no where in the Holy Quran has despair or desperation been mentioned or advocated. We have been taught repeatedly in the Holy Quran to be hopeful and try our best to excel.
