National Khuddamul Ahmadiyya members visit United Nations

The Ahmadiyya Muslim Youth Association (AMYA), an auxiliary of Ahmadiyya Muslim Community USA, came into the heart of the United Nations on Friday, November 14, 2014, to host a historical event entitled "Islamic Solutions to Muslim Youth Radicalization." The event brought together representatives of the United Nations, members of the U.S. State Department, diplomatic missions to the United Nations from more than 20 countries (including Ambassadors and Deputy Ambassadors), university professors, religious clergy, NGO leaders, and Muslim youth leaders to analyze and present a solution that will globally turn the tide of radicalization of Muslim young men.

Before the main event, the AMYA hosted a Press Conference, which was moderated by its Assistant President, Dr. Ahmad Chaudhry. He introduced AMYA's National Vice President, Dr. Basiyr Rodney, who delivered a statement about why AMYA has come to meet with leaders and diplomats of the United Nations, as well as how we can address the issue of Muslim youth radicalization. An entire crew from Al Jazeera America attended the press conference and asked several questions in advance of the main event.

The main event was moderated by National Spokesperson and Assistant President of Ahmadiyya Muslim Youth Association, Harris Zafar, who welcomed the audience after the Quran was recited by a Muslim youth. The Vice President and Missionary in Charge of Ahmadiyya Muslim Community USA, Imam Naseem Mahdi, beautifully and passionately outlined Islam's teachings towards peace and confronted claims by radical groups like ISIS who claim that they speak for the teachings of Islam. Imam Naseem Mahdi Sahib eloquently clarified that the actions of groups like ISIS run in stark contrast to the true teachings of Islam. Report by Harris Zafar.

The keynote address was then delivered by the National President of Ahmadiyya Muslim Youth Association, Dr. Bilal Rana. Dr. Rana directly addressed the manner in which not only the teachings of Islam but also Muslim leadership can provide an active and engaging support network for Muslim youth. He explained how such a formula can enable young Muslim men to not only discover a sense of belonging, but to also feel engaged in activities generating a positive impact.

Dr. Rana presented Ahmadiyya Muslim Youth Association's formula for protecting Muslim youth from radicalization by not only spreading education but also engaging the youth in discussion and civic activities. Since this formula has proven successful for the Ahmadiyya Muslim Youth Association, it's leadership decided to undertake this noble effort to work with the diplomatic international community to guide them on replicating this success in countries around the world as a true antidote to Muslim youth radicalization.

"We cannot solve extremism with military excesses of our own," said Dr. Rana during his remarks. "There can be no any excuse for the actions of Muslim youth in the West who radicalize. But we must help and prevent them from radicalizing, not by misunderstanding a faith they hold dear. But rather, by engaging them with love, reconciliation, and justice."

The main event concluded with an interactive Q&A session in which Imam Naseem Mahdi and Dr. Rana addressed questions and comments from various guests in attendance. The event drew even more press, including not only Al Jazeera America but also New York Times, Associated Press, Fox News, and Urdu News.

After the conclusion of the program, Dr. Rana and some members of his youth leadership were given a guided tour of the United Nations facility. During this tour, the members saw a picture of Chaudhry Zafrullah Khan hanging among pictures of other past presidents of the United Nations.

On Wednesday November 26, at 7:30pm, we hosted an Interfaith Thanksgiving program at Bait-uz-Zafar. We had three of our neighboring houses of worship participate in the program.

This was the 4th year we have held this program.

Each year we change the location where we hold the program. This year, it was our Jama'at's turn to host the meeting. The other three congregations who participated were: the Israel Center of Conservative Judaism, the Christ Lutheran Church, and the Hillcrest Jewish Center.

Although there were thunderstorms and heavy rain that evening, there were approximately 90 people at the program, Alhamdulillah, the majority of the attendees were guests. Our young khadim, Salman Ahmad, spoke on "What Thanksgiving Means to Me as a Muslim".
