Tabligh Report

Interfaith Conference

On April 26th, the Jamaat hosted an in-house interfaith conference at Bait-ul-Zafar. Representatives from 8 religious organizations attended the event each of whom gave a speech on the subject “Pursuit for Peace”. The program lasted approximately 4 hours and proved to be an interactive and dynamic open forum with 57 guests in attendance. All 57 guests were visiting Bait-ul-Zafar for the first time. Complementary Jamaat pens were handed to each guest. The event received media coverage from a Bengali TV station.

On April 29th the heads of various religious organizations held an interfaith meeting to discuss and make arrangements for upcoming events. The Jamaat participated in that and it was collectively agreed upon to hold an interfaith dialogue on June 7th 2015, in which the Jamaat will be representing the True Islam (Ahmadiyyat). We are also the only Islamic group to speak on behalf of Islam.

On May 16th UTC Seminary in Manhattan held an interfaith conference on Peace - for which we were invited to represent the true Islam. The opening session was initiated by an Islamic prayer (Surah Al-Fatiha with English translation). Attending the event were 67 guests. The Jamaat was recognized and highly praised for all its efforts in the many community service events we’ve organized/participated in throughout the years. We distributed a copy of ***The Philosophy of the Teachings of Islam; Islam and Human Rights and True Love of Holy Prophet Muhammad*** ^(saw). The guest of honor was the Minister of Foreign Affairs (also titled The Ambassador of Peace within the United Nations) of Nigeria Mrs. Carolin. We met with the minister and invited her to visit Bait-uz-Zafar (which she later did).

On May 22nd the Ambassador of Peace of Nigeria visited Bait-ul-Zafar and brought with her many of her colleagues. We presented to them a brief history our movement including our current state of affairs. In conclusion she promised to support/take our mission to the United Nations including Nigeria.

Looking forward, we’re currently in talks with St. John’s University and New York University to hold religious lectures in their fall semesters (2015).

Alhamdulillah our Regional Ijtema was held on May 10th 2015 at Masjid Bait-uz-Zafar, Queens New York.

Ijtema day was started at 8:30am -10:am with breakfast/registration. Program Started at 10:15 chaired by Mohtram Basharat Wadan Sahib National Qaid Ansarullah USA as representative of Sadr Majlis Ansarullah USA. Recitation of Holy Qur'an (Chapter 78, verses 32-41) recited by brother Yanful Majeed Sahib (Bronx Majlis), along with translation of the recited verses. After the Ansar pledge, Urdu poem of Hazrat Masih Maud (A.S.) was presented Melodiously by Manzoor Malik Sahib (Brooklyn Majlis) and English translation was provided by Naib Nazim Mohtram Rafi Ahmed Sahib. Bangla Book Stall

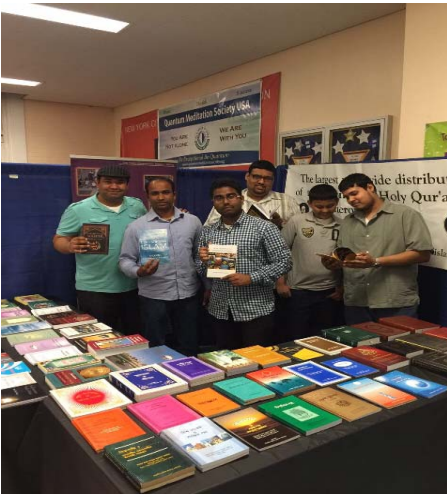

National Finance Secretary Sahib has given the attached email message to me, about our Chanda collections for the year ending this June 30th. He has otherwise shared his concern about there being only six weeks left in the financial year to make up this gap.

I ask of all of you to make an extra effort to bridge the gap.

Emphasis also needs to be placed on collections from those who for their own reason overlook the participation in Allah's Blessings in keeping up with the dictates of the Messiah *as*, specifically Chanda Aam and Jalsa Salana.

The analysis given also is that Lajna members are somewhat disproportionate in claiming an exemption. Their income needs to be purified just as much as the men's, and this needs attention.
