Hanif Sahib was our representative on behalf of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, and partook in every question asked. The highlight of the event was when a Christian gentlemen in the audience made a comment in regards to all religions and their leaders – he noted the hypocrisy of religious leaders whereby they themselves don't always practice what they preach. Our respected Imam Sahib responded to this comment by shining light on the true teachings of Islam and the importance of the Promised Messiah (AS).

Lajna Report

After listening to the live concluding address of Huzoor (atba) during Jalsa Salana Germany, the Lajna meeting began with Quranic recitation and translation by Amtul Hayee Mariyam. Hadith and translation was read by Saba Noreen. Sadr Sahiba read the Lajna pledge. It was followed by the Talim program which was conducted by Tehmina Rafique and Zina Sahiba. They talked about the Importance of Ramadhan. They also conducted a quiz session which was informative and also served the purpose of revision of the basics.

Next, the Tarbiyyat program was led by Farah Ahmad. She discussed the 1st and 3rd conditions of Bai'at. She outlined the basics such as: to offer 5 daily prayers, thank Allah, recite Durood, asking for forgiveness, etc. She spoke about shirk and the different forms of shirk. She also discussed the hidden idols associated with raising children and gave some examples and asked the members to give their personal examples. Some examples were: helping kids with homework during Salat time, hitting kids rather than explaining to them what wrong they did, not sharing knowledge, etc. She urged sisters to not make worldly means as form of reliance and reminded sisters that the Quran calls people to accept the oneness of Allah and severely prohibits people from associating partners with His personality or attributes.

This was followed by the health session conducted by Kanwal Bhatti, on the topic, "Eat Healthy and Feel Healthy". The Tabligh Program followed and was led by Salamat Majeed Sahiba. She talked about using different resources for preaching. She asked sisters to create a new heaven and new earth for themselves and their children especially in Ramadhan as we should focus on changing our lives for the better.

At the end of the meeting, Sadr sahiba made announcements about Chanda dues and funds being collected for various schemes. The funds she highlighted were: Lajna hall fund, Eid gift fund, Humanity First fund for Tanzania hospital and Guatemala fund. The meeting concluded with silent prayers and was followed by Salat (Zuhr).

NorthEast Regional Atfal Rally

Message from Amir Sahib, USA

Fidya: For people who are unable to observe their fast in Ramadan because of illness, inability or travel etc., the Quranic injunction is that they should pay Fidya as a recompense for the lost opportunity to observe fast. **The rate of Fidya, depending on individual circumstances, is equivalent to two meals for every fast which has been missed. This year the rate of Fidya is set to a minimum of \$150 for the month of Ramadhan at the rate of \$5 per day.

Fitrana: Fitrana is a Sadqa, which is obligatory on each earning head of household. Its purpose is to help the poor brethren of the community so that they can fully enjoy the happiness of Eidul Fitr. It is advisable that Fitrana should be paid as early as possible starting the month of Ramadan so that the management can distribute it among the deserving on time. In any case, it should be paid before Eid prayer.

**The rate of Fitrana is fixed @ \$ 5.00 per person (including even a new born before Eid prayer). The head of household is responsible to pay on behalf of his/her dependents. If due to financial hardship someone is unable to pay according to full rate, he/she can pay @ \$ 2.50 per person.

Eid Fund: To make this festival of Islam an occasion of joy and pleasure, one is expected to contribute something before Eid for those who are poor and less fortunate. Eid Fund should be paid according to donor's capacity.

Nasirat and 15-25 Lajna Sleepover

The regional sleepover for the Nasirat and young Lajna of the New York Metro region was held on the weekend of June 13 and 14. Nasirat and Lajna members from Brooklyn, Queens, Long Island and the Bronx all attended the sleepover weekend. The first day of the sleepover was scheduled with presentations and workshops for both groups. The Nasirat participated in workshops about peer pressure, and how they can maintain a relationship with Allah. The young Lajna had workshops on maintaining marital harmony as well keeping a close relationship with Allah. The girls were then served lunch and then had an activity where they learned how to sew and hem their own clothes. After dinner, some girls stayed over for the night. The next day, the Nasirat went on a field trip to the Adventure Land amusement park while the young Lajna went indoor rock-climbing. All of the girls enjoyed both days of the sleepover immensely. Income Criteria for Lazmi Chandajaat

Earning members include:

- ♦ All members (male and female) of your Jama'at who have jobs and earn wages, salaries, tips, etc.
- All members (male and female) who are self employed.
- All members (male and female) who have income through retirement, social security benefits, personal allowances etc.
- All members (male and female) who have income through rents, royalties, investments, farming, etc.
- All members (male and female) who are students and have income through full time or part time jobs.

All earning members (male and female) should be asked to inform you about their income. This is the net income after allowed deductions (i.e., federal, state, and local taxes, social security taxes, and any insurance compulsory under the law).

Only self-employed members can deduct expenses incurred for earning that income from their gross income, e.g. car/vehicle operating expenses, rent on premises, electric bills, workshop expenses, etc.

The installments of payments on mortgage/monthly rent are not allowed for deduction from gross income.

Members participated in the Bai'at held on the last day of Jalsa Salana Germany, including Atfal who were in the midst of their Regional Rally. Later in the day, members watched Huzoor's concluding speech of the Jalsa. Ansar and Lajna members delayed their meetings to listen to Hazoor's speech live from Germany.
