One can google for hotel accommodation in Amritsar that is an hour away with decent accommodation cost about one thousand Indian rupees per night and the hotel will arrange transport to / from Qadian if one desires perhaps at a collective bargain fare. Please note that 1000 Indian rupees is about \$25.00.

# Lajna Imaillah Report

Lajna Imaillah held their monthly meeting on Saturday, August 9, 2008 at Baitul Zafar. The meeting started with recitation of the Holy Quran and English translation by Sana Nasir, followed by Urdu translation by Ayesha Bajwa. Hadith with Urdu translation was read by Shazila Rizwan. English translation was read by Wajeha Ashraf followed by a poem by Farhana Ahmad Kanta with English translation. Talim Secretary Naeema Mahmood discussed in detail Chapter 2 of the book 'Truth About The Split' and 'Aina-e-Sadagat' in Urdu, explaining how Khwaja Kamaluddin and Maulana Mohammad Ali brought about the split because they wanted to end the Khilafat. Then Farah Ahmad, Tarbiyyat Secretary discussed in detail about Truthfulness, which is the second condition of Bai'at . She also read out Quranic verses about Ramadan and discussed them in detail. Rehana Nayyar, Acting President, then talked about health issues and how to avoid health problems by exercising and eating a balanced diet. Packets of different pamphlets detailing exercise and a balanced diet were handed out by the Acting President to members. She also reminded members to pay all their chandas and relayed National President Shahnaz Butt's message that Amir Sahib wants Lajna to collect \$25,000 for Khilafat Centenary Celebration Fund. Even if members have already contributed to this Fund, they should contribute more. The National Lajna President's additional message for members to watch the Al Jazeera video on the condition of Indonesian Ahmadis was also conveyed by the Acting President and information about the website where this video could be accessed was handed out. The National Lajna President's letter about her observations on the functioning of Lajna at Jalsa Salana was then read out to members by the Acting President in accordance with directives received from the National President. The Acting President then informed members about swimming lessons that have been arranged for Lajna members and reminded them to participate in Wagar-e-Amal at the new mosque. She also informed members about National Youth Program to be held on August 17th at Baitul Zafar and reminded them that everyone should participate. In the end Huzoor's latest khutba was discussed in detail and the meeting ended with silent prayers.

Minimal standard of sacrifice for Chanda Wasiyyat Hissa Amad in the USA has been revised by Majlis Karpardaz with the approval of Syedna Hadrat Khalifatul Masih V (ab). According to instructions received here the revised minimal standard has been set on a monthly income of \$250 (two hundred and fifty dollars). Hence, any Moosi/Moosiah who has no personal source of income, and has previously been paying \$20 per month as Chanda Hissa Amad Wasiyyat (provided that his/her rate of Wasiyyat is 1/10) shall now pay a sum of \$25 per month.

The above revision does not apply to students who will continue to pay their Chanda Hissa Amad as agreed upon previously with Majlis Karpardaz. Please note that for students there is no fixed monthly/yearly amount for Chanda Hissa Amad. However, they must reach a mutual understanding with Majlis Karparadaz through National Wasaya Office for a minimal payment.

# New Bait-uz-Zafar Update





# Jama'at-e-Ahmadiyyat Progress shared by Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih V

#### **Expansion of Jama'at:**

As of last year Jama'at was established in **189** countries, this year Jama'at has expanded into four additional countries thus raising the total to **193**. The four countries are: Tajikistan, Iceland, Tokelau and Latvia

- In Tajikistan, a new convert Izzatullah Sahib from Moscow, Russia (who accepted Ahmadiyyat by seeing Hadhrat Ahmad in a vision) became a very active and through his efforts a new Jama'at has been established in Tajikistan with 60 new Baits.
- 4 Baits took place in a tiny island of South Pacific with a population of 20,000, known as Tokelau.
- Two Baits have been realized in Latvia.
- 11 members delegation will attend Germany Jalsa Insha'Allah, one Bait was realized in Iceland.
- In Aljazair over 200 Baits were realized , the source of expansion was MTA programming.
- Tunisia, Macedonia, Hungry, Malta, Estonia, Kosovo, San Morino also saw expansion of Jama'ats. Ethiopia was assigned to Kenya, Over 500 Bai'ts were realized and 5 chapters established in Ethiopia.

#### Renewal of Past contacts: In 48 countries contacts have been rejuvinated

- Ghana leads Jama'at Aalamgeer in this vein and renewed 163,000 contacts and established 128 Jam'ats. So far Ghana has renewed 767,000 contacts in the last seven years. The world has seen a glimpse of this at Jalsa Ghana.
- Nigeria renewed 123,095 contacts this year
- Burkina Faso renewed 6000 contacts
- Ivory Coast succeeded in renewing 38000 contacts
- Sierra Leone in spite of all difficulties succeeded in rejuvenating 40,000 contacts
- Kenya renewed 5000 contacts

#### **Establishments of New Jam'ats:**

• 593 new Jam'ats were established. Additionally, at 515 locations Jam'at has been established for the first time. India is the leader in this vein with 145 new chapters established.

Ghana = 60 Burkina Faso = 31 Benin = 10 Kenya= 10 Uganda 18, Sierra Leone = 12 Guniea Bissau 12

- Leone: A lady watched MTA and was moved to join Ahmadiyyat. Her husband was opposed, she wrote a letter to me. Within a month, he finally accepted Ahmadiyyat. These are the first people in the city to join.
- Quartier city.: Muslims were here from before, they came here via Spain. One fellow said that I watch MTA regularly and requested Bait. Tulof; there was no ahmedi in this town. Web radio was started and through this means one student of law accepted Ahmadiyyat.

#### • Impact of Huzoor's visits:

- Ivorry coast: Before Jalsa Ghana, for four month missionaries preached in an area of Ivory Coast with no success. A delegation of 28 people went to attend Jalsa Ghana. These people met Huzoor Aqdas. After coming back home they joined the Jam'at. In three villages, Imams accepted Ahmadiyyat and joined with their Mosques. All these 28 people accepted Ahmadiyyat. A parcel of 3 canal land was donated to Jam'at in addition.
- Burkina Faso: In Dasa region, one Imam created extensive obstacles in our Tabligh and advised the village dwellers not to

#### **NEW Mosques:**

- 351 new mosques were added this year; 149 of these were new and 202 were prebuilt.
- Mosques were built in Detroit for 1.0 Million, Columbus and St. Louis In USA. In Canada Calgary mosque was a great addition and created a great impact throughout Canada and the world over. Mosques have been built in UK and Germany
- Following is the list of countries and the number of mosques built during the last year.

India = 43; Bhutan/Nepal = 2; Bangladesh = 9; Indonesia = 2 the mosques in Indonesia now total 387; Ghana = 10; Nigeria = 11 new and 56 pre-built;

- Cameroon and Chad = First new Mosque; Equatorial Guinea = A plot has been purchased; Somalia = 1; Sierra Leone = 9 (2 new and 7 prebuilt), Liberia = 2
- Uganda = 12; Burkina Faso = 55; Mali = 71; Benin = 15; Niger = 10
- Spain= A plot for a mosque in Valencia has been bought.

# Jama'at-e-Ahmadiyyat Progress shared by Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih V

#### **Mission Houses:**

 142 increased this year to a new total of 2011 in 102 countries. Largest number increased in India where 62 additional centers were established.

#### **Printing Presses:**

We currently have printing press facilities in 11 countries, 8 of which are in African countries. A new building has been established for a printing press in Kenya, Tanzania and Ghana. Raqueem press in London produced 240500 last year while African facilities produced 445000 pieces.

#### **Translation of Holy Quran:**

- 68 have been completed that include 4 that were completed this year.
- Russian translation wit notes have been revised and printed in Kazakhstan
- 15 parts in Moray language has been printed. Shaikil Ahmad Munir Sahib has done this.
- 45 countries printed 621 pieces in 31 languages with a total of 2124367.

#### **Bookstalls/Exhibitions:**

• 957 bookstalls were organized and the message reached to 666223 people.

Jama'at Norway arranged library exhibitions at 34 locations. About 152000 people benefited from these and 40 newspapers covered these activities.

• 987 newspapers covered Jama'at news that was read by about 7-8 million people.

#### Waqf e Nau scheme:

• 2325 Waqifeen were added this year to a new total of 37136 Waqifeen in the world. This figure includes 23765 boys and 13771 girls. A ratio of 2:1 is being maintained.

#### Schools/Hospitals:

- Under Majlis Nusrat Jehan 36 hospital are in operation in 12 countries where 40 doctors are busy treating the ailing humanity. Also 510 schools are in operation in 11 countries.
- A new hospital is being established in Kenya and Liberia.

#### TV/Radio programs:

- During last year 1051 TV programs for 699 hours were broadcasted. 215 hours of 7051 Radio programs wee organized that were listed by 6 million listeners.
- Solar energy plants: Over 60 stations have been installed in Ghana, Gambia, Benin, Burkina Faso, Togo, Mali and Ivory Coast.
- Humanity First has been registered in 28 countries. 15 IT centers are in operation where 16000 students are learning Computer languages.

#### **Wasiyyat Report:**

• There were 38183 Moosies in 2004 and now we have 88500 Moosies. The top Jam'ats are Pakistan, Germany, and Indonesia.
