General Meeting:

This month's regular majlis meeting was held on Sunday, October 4th at Bait-uz-Zafar. The theme of this month's meeting was, "Forbearance – Coping with Trials and Tribulations". The meeting started with the recitation of Holy Quran by Mohd. Afzal sahib from Chapter 2 Verse 156, 157. Ansar Pledge was recited by Zaeem sahib. Khalifatul Masih's religious guidelines were presented by Naeem Mansoor sahib. Zaeem sahib, along with Iqbal Ahmad, discussed the questions relating to tarbiyyat and held an interactive discussion with all the members. The health topic regarding strokes was discussed by Attah Alhassan sahib. Lajna Monthly Report

Queens Lajna held their annual Seerat-un-Nabi day which started with the recitation of the Holy Quran by Aniqa Farakh. Next, Hadith was read by Naeema Ahmad Sahiba along with the commentary and a Nazm was recited by Bariah Ahmad.

The first speech was prepared by Sister Sadaf Latif on the "Importance of the Kalima Tayyiba." In her speech, she discussed the importance of the Kalima Tayyiba and the intense worship of Allah by the Holy Prophet (saw) who always prayed for his children whom he treated with love and kindness.

The second speech was on the "Tolerant Teachings of Islam as Personified by the Holy Prophet (SAW)" by Sister Sadia Chaudhry, who discussed how the Quran preaches the rights of Non-Muslims and the actions of Jihadi organizations are misleading the world and what Islam truly teaches. She explained how the Holy Prophet (SAW) allowed the Jews to worship in the Mosque because it was the house of God. The Holy Prophet (saw) saw people of all religions as equals and tolerated people of all religions, as should we.

Next, we had a Panel Discussion on the "Rules the Battles of Islam Gave Us" which was conducted by Sisters Farah Ahmad, Khoshnoor Paracha, and Dr. Salamat Majeed Sahiba. They started off by explaining why wars took place and emphasized that they began after the Holy Prophet (saw) started spreading the message of Allah and Islam. However, the Holy Prophet (saw) never started a war to protect himself, but to protect the world of Islam from its transgressors. In the world today, ISIS is spreading their message through extreme violence, going against all teachings of Islam in terms of rules for war. It is necessary for all Ahmadi parents to discuss these matters with their children so that they are aware of the dangers of these groups, as these groups target the youth through social media. The last part of this discussion described what the Holy Quran says about war. The panelists explained that one of the main conditions for starting a war is if failing to fight jeopardizes peace. Permission to fight is only given to those who have been attacked and the fighting should only take place for the sake of God, not out of anger.

Qaseeda was prepared by the Nasirat, after which an Urdu Speech was presented by Sister Zainab Mohar in Urdu, on the Qualities of the Holy Prophet (saw). A similar speech was prepared by Sister Alina Ahmed in English, "The High Morale of the Holy Prophet (saw).

In conclusion, a small quiz was prepared on the topics covered during the session and candy was given to those who answer correctly. Announcements were made and the meeting ended with silent Prayers.
